

Hotel Accommodations in Detroit, MI

See below a list of hotels in Downtown Detroit that TechTown recommends out-of-town guests stay in while visiting TechTown. You will also see a map on page 2 with the QLINE stops. The QLINE runs along Woodward Ave and is *free* transportation that will take you from Downtown to TechTown Detroit. The Amsterdam QLINE stop is a short 4-minute walk from TechTown.

The hotel also features The Apparatus Room, a New American Cuisine with drinks made from the city's finest mixologists.
